Child will present two demonstrations at Jill Prescott's Ecole de Cuisine in Mequon, Wis., near Milwaukee, in the program sponsored by the Milwaukee chapter of the American Institute of Wine and Food.

For the 7 p.m., Oct. 4 class, Child will demonstrate choucroute garni (an Alsatian cabbage and sausage dish), oysters broiled in garlic butter and baked apple slices. At 2:30 p.m., Oct. 5, she will demonstrate rack of lamb with rosemary, pommes duchesse (baked sliced potatoes with cream and cheese) and creme caramel. The cost of each class is \$150.

The Wisconsin Chefs' Salute to Julia Child will be at 2 p.m. Oct. 6 and includes a tasting of cheeses and breads, an illustrated talk on film, food and sex by professor Bert Sonnenfeld of the University of Southern California, an auction of food items and a six-course dinner with matching wines. Cost is \$125.
